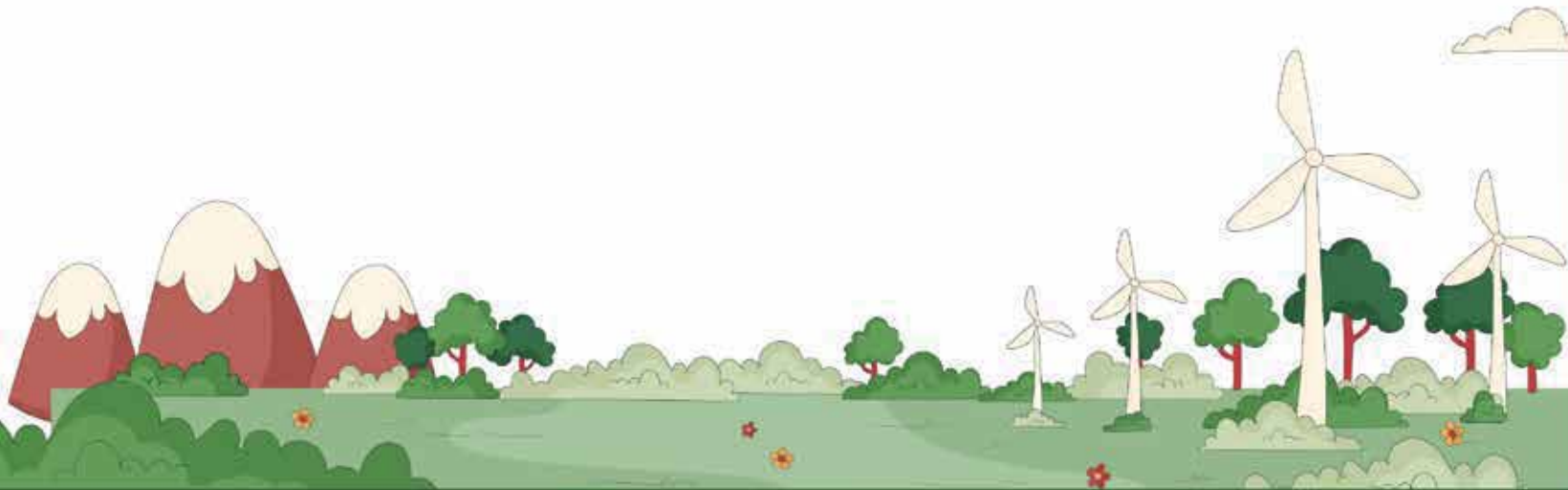

RURAL DEVELOPMENT

Nirmaan is committed to sustainable rural development, recently launching initiatives across **11 PVTG Villages in Nagarkurnool**, benefiting over 700 Chenchu tribe members. Our efforts include infrastructure enhancements such as **community toilets, water tanks, livelihood programs, cattle sheds, borewells and school refurbishments**, alongside **sports equipment distribution** to promote wellness and inclusivity among community and school children. In **Kothapeta, Hyderabad**, we inaugurated a **Primary Health Care center**, furnishing it with essential facilities and renovating it at a cost of Rs. 12 lakhs. Additionally, a 2,000-liter capacity **Mineral Water Plant** was installed to provide clean drinking water to the villagers. These actions reflect our dedication to holistic community empowerment and well-being.

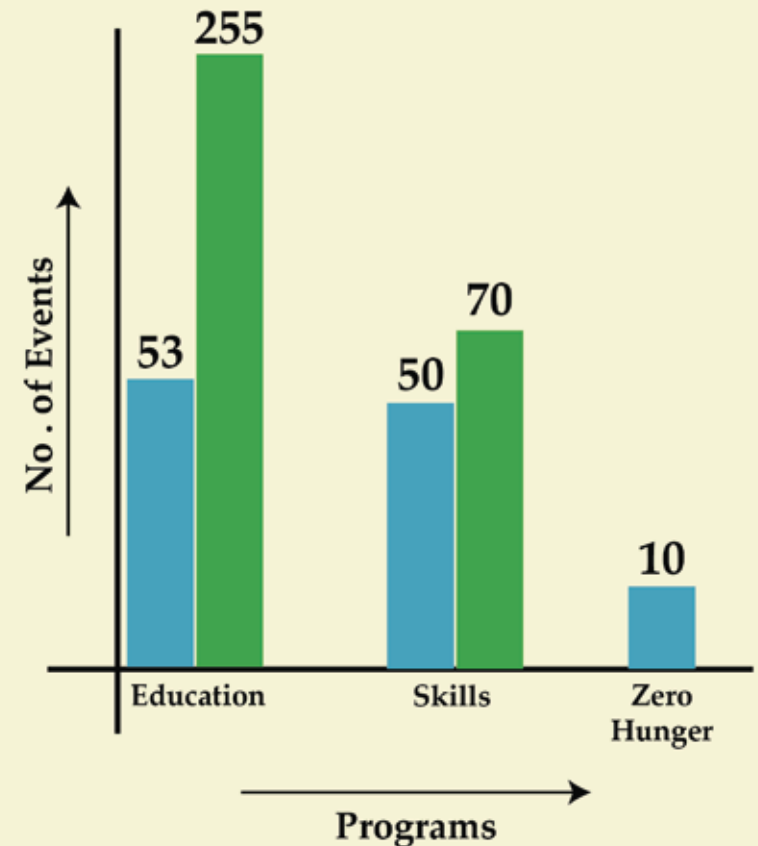
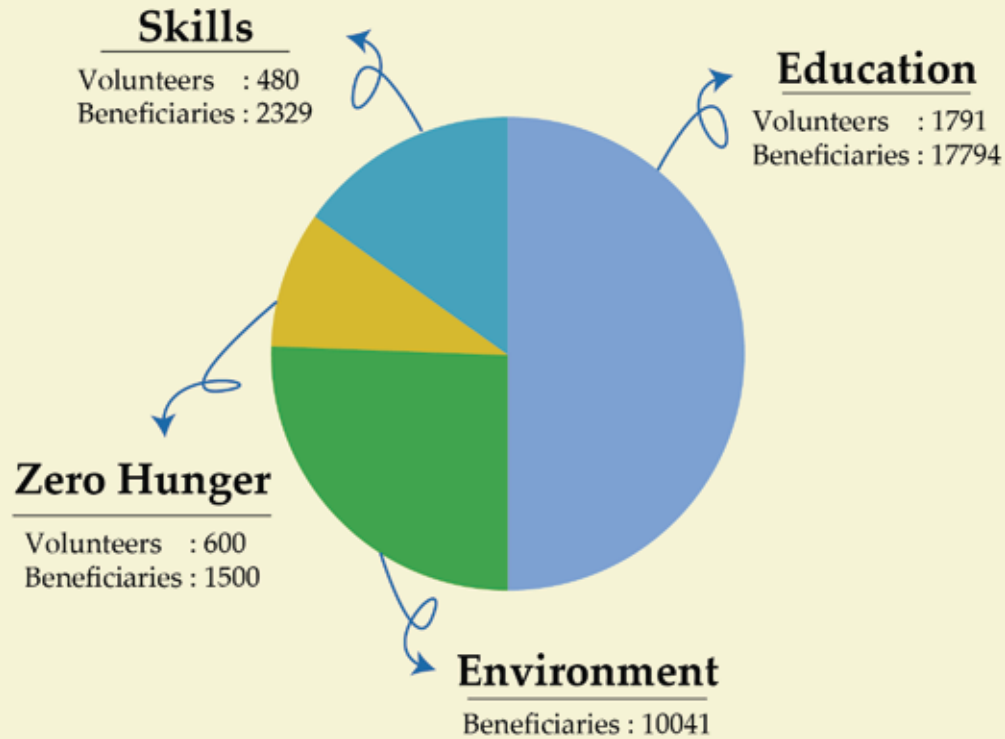

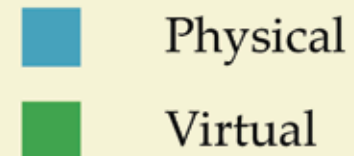
