SKILL DEVELOPMENT & ENTREPRENEURSHIP

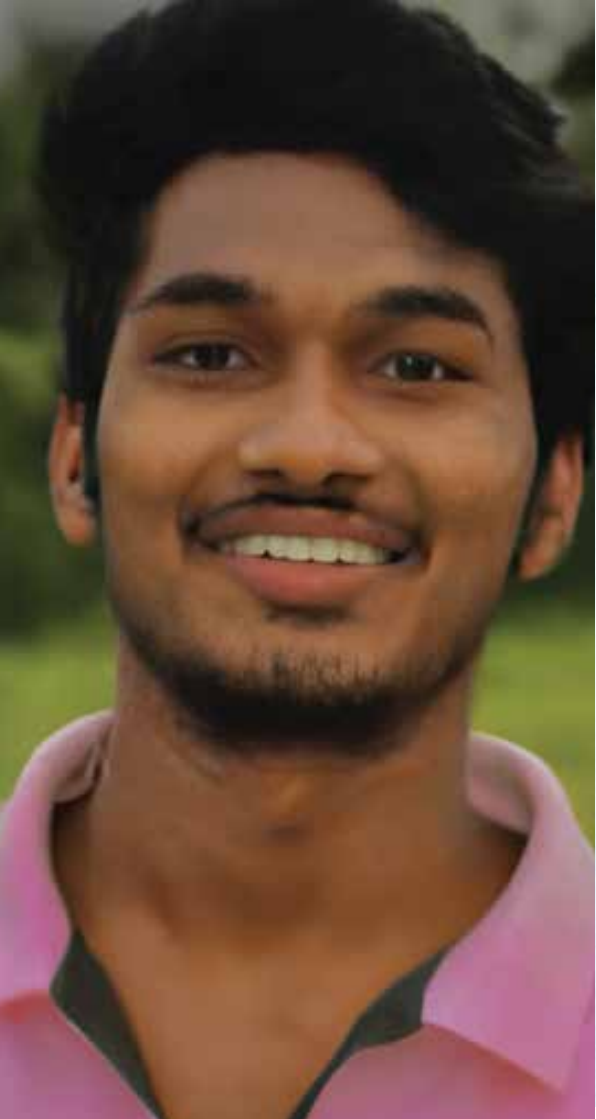
